Mission Statement: The mission of the *Truth and Courage* Newspaper is to publish a school newspaper that is completely student created. Each month, we will produce one issue of *Truth and Courage*. We want to encourage students to express their opinions, creativity, humor, and much more through writing, photos, drawings, or anything they can submit to our newspaper.

Mission Statement Broken Down:

Description: The *Truth and Courage* Newspaper is a student-led school newspaper. Each month, we produce one issue of *Truth and Courage*. Students may work on one issue, all of them, or anywhere in between. Students may submit work to and help with any of the different sections. The sections are: **Articles, Interviews, Graphics, Photography, and Poetry**. Students also may help with formatting the layout of the newspaper. Though we try to be as student-led as possible, we also have a faculty advisor. Our faculty advisor will offer writing support, help us edit articles, and check our content for anything inappropriate for a school newspaper. We are the only student-run newspaper on campus, and are the most frequently publishing newspaper to feature student work. We want to give students a place to have their best work seen by the community, and to give them some experience with publishing a newspaper.

Our Goal: The *Truth and Courage* Newspaper has one main goal: to give students of Dublin School a voice.
